

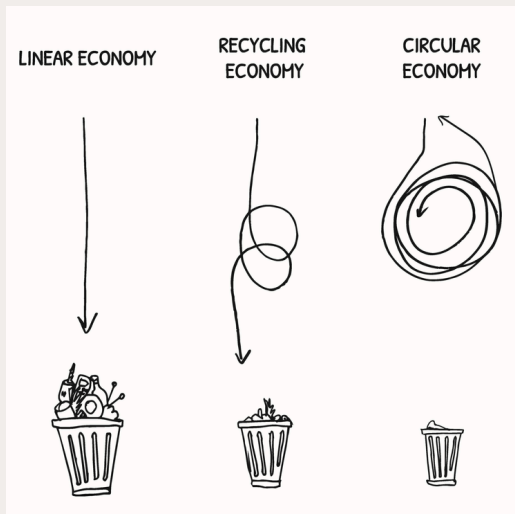

Dives into Key Themes Driving Circular Systems Change

October 22 opens with international dialogue on how governments are shaping national circular economy strategies—framed by emerging global trends and grounded in Asia-Pacific realities. Taiwan’s draft Circular Economy Roadmap will be featured as a case study in regional policymaking. The day continues with immersive industry showcases across six key sectors—Agriculture & food, Textiles, High-tech and electronics, Architecture and Construction, Plastics and packaging, and Energy and key materials—highlighting how Taiwan and Asia-Pacific leaders are turning global challenges into circular opportunities.

On **October 23**, the spotlight shifts to system-level enablers. Five parallel sessions will explore five core themes: Policy & Governance, Financial Enablers, Business Transformation, Trade & Traceability, and Consumer Engagement. These strategic dialogues will equip public and private sector leaders with insights to advance circular solutions across industries and value chains.
